Cazadero Town Hall Notes Coast: Protection and Access

Challenges:

- · Ditches have not been cleaned on Austin Creek Road for 35 years.
- Cazadero Hwy has not been paved in at least 20 years. It needs a whole new base, not just a band-aid.
- · Coast protection—beaches are not clean.

- · Empower state coast patrols to also do clean-up during slack time.
- · Coordinate volunteer efforts.
- · Accelerate priority for LED conversion of street lights.

Cazadero Town Hall Notes Homelessness

Challenges:

- · Not enough affordable housing.
- · High/increasing rents.
- · Inadequate mental health.

- More mental health support. Housing with services for people with mental health and drug problems.
- · Can we have something like Habitat for Humanity for apartment construction?
- · Prefab apartment buildings-Press Democrat article this morning.

Cazadero Town Hall Notes Affordable Housing

Challenges:

- · Too many VRBOs taking up what could be rentals.
- · Cost of housing in Bay Area pushing people farther and farther away from cities.

Solutions:

· Need to build housing with a higher percentage of way below the market rate.

Cazadero Town Hall Notes Roads

Challenges:

- · Lots of roads in terrible shape.
- · Pothole filling not working.
- Logs (at least 7) over the road on Old Cazadero between East Austin Creek and the gate up by the siren, which is a serious fire hazard.
- · Open Sten Bridge at Duncan and Rade Road.
- County approved repairing Cazadero Hwy only to 3-mile bridge needs to be repaired all the way to town.

- · Hire private contractor to clean logs on Old Cazadero Road.
- · Put together a roads repair master plan that includes bike lanes and follow it.

Cazadero Town Hall Notes Russian River: Environment & Health

Challenges:

- · Not enough water.
- · Algae from crop runoff.
- Nitrate and phosphorus pollution and concentration with low flow. With low flow to benefit Russian River lagoon will water conserved remain in reservoirs and aquifers or be sold by the water agency? Will there be a trial period to establish data necessary for reasonable decisions?

- · Let more water through the entire watershed.
- · Have big wineries and farms divert runoff from the river.

Cazadero Town Hall Tourism Impacts: Wineries, VRBOs

Challenges:

- · Too many VRBOS.
- · TOT money not returned to communities,
- Tourism is a historical aspect of the Russian River area, resulting in a greater need for more emergency services and road repair.

- · Limit by annual raffle.
- · Supervisors take action on getting TOT money to communities that generate it.

Cazadero Town Hall Notes Other

Challenges:

- · We need an Electrical Vehicle charging station in Cazadero.
- · Consolidation of rural volunteer fire department.
- Inadequate REDCOM coverage.
- · Off channel water storage along Austin Creek.
- · Historic summer dams have been banned for over 20 years.
- Since 1992, logging practices negatively affect slash and squirt on water in creeks and are a fire hazard of dead trees left standing.
- · No illegal marijuana growth.
- · Red sand for frost-mine tailings?

- · County will need to provide funding for equipment, training, and stations.
- · County must improve emergency communication services.
- Modification of ordinances need to allow for storage.
